



When do the concerts start?

Live music starts at 6:00 PM featuring one of our local high school jazz ensembles/bands. The headlining band starts at 7:00 PM.

Will there be food?

Golf Cart Shuttles/Parking?

For the safety and health of our community and volunteers, we will not be offering golf cart shuttle services. Limited handicapped parking spaces will be available in West Shore Bank's Loomis Street parking lot. General parking for the event is available in any downtown Ludington city parking lot and permitted street parking. Parking fills up fast, please plan accordingly.

Can I bring my own drinks?

Yes, you can bring your own drinks and coolers. Beer and wine are allowed within Waterfront Park, but no glass bottles. Containers up to 2 liters are permitted.

What seating is available?

The concerts are BYOS (bring your own seating). Lawn/beach chairs and blankets are welcome for comfortable seating.

Where can I donate?

Volunteers will bring donation boxes throughout the event to accept donations during the concerts. Donations are also accepted online at RhythmAndDunes.com. Proceeds benefit local high school music programs.
