WEST SHORE BANK'S RHYTHM & DUNES RAISES AN ALL-TIME HIGH OF \$20,500

LUDINGTON, MI - West Shore Bank announced this week that, for the 12th year, proceeds from its Rhythm & Dunes summer concert fundraiser will benefit local high school band programs.

The donations are distributed between three Mason County school districts – Ludington Area Schools, Mason County Central, and Mason County Eastern. This year's donations totaled \$20,500, the highest amount in its 12-year history. The funds were raised through in-person and online donations, merchandise sales and food vendor fees. Additionally, West Shore Bank received a \$1,000 donation from the Ludington Fraternal Order of Eagles, and donations from the Ryan Knudsen Memorial Fund.

Over 12 years, West Shore Bank's Rhythm and Dunes fundraiser concert series has raised \$137,250, which has made a real impact on local band programs.
